

## 2010-2011 UPDATED DRESS CODE

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING CHANGES:

### Hair

Students hair must be clean, neatly groomed and his or her natural color. A neat hairstyle of reasonable length; bangs above the eyebrows for both girls and boys and above the collar in back for the boys is required. No eccentric styles, shavings, colorings, cuts, tails etc are permitted.

Hair violations will be corrected the same day

### Jewelry/Cosmetics

A wristwatch, a ring, post earrings or hoops no bigger than dimes (one in each ear) and a religious medal/cross may be worn. Long or dangling earrings are in violation of the dress code. Boys are not to wear earrings. Girls are not to wear nail polish or make-up. Girls will be sent to the Nurse's office to remove nail polish or make up.

### School Uniform

For students in K-8 uniforms are purchased from Coed Uniform Company, 100 Broadway, Elmwood Park, New Jersey, 07407 (201-796-4220). If you would like to order on line the school code is 094. Unless excused by the Principal, students wear the uniforms on all school days. The prescribed uniform will be worn at all times.

### **SCHOOL SNEAKERS:**

Sneakers are to be worn only on gym day with the gym uniform.

**ALL black or ALL white sneakers are to be worn.**

Sneakers are **NOT** to be worn with the Spring Uniform.

### **GIRLS SCHOOL SHOES:**

Girls are to wear black rubber soled tie, loafer style, or Mary Jane style shoe

Ballerina shoes, open back, open toed, high heeled, clogs, flip flops are not safe and are not to be worn.

### **BOYS SCHOOL SHOES:**

Boys are to wear black rubber soled shoes not sneakers.

### **GIRLS K-4**

GLEN PLAID JUMPER OR BLACK DRESS SLACKS - May be worn all year long with:

1. Short or Long Sleeve White Blouse (Peter Pan collar) with the jumper
2. White Turtleneck with ASCA Logo with the jumper or black slacks
3. White or Gray Knit ASCA shirt (short or long sleeve) with the black slacks
4. BLACK Uniform Sweater with ASCA Logo

BLACK WALKING SHORTS – May be worn with White or Gray Knit ASCA shirt and SCHOOL SHOES.  
(May be worn from September 1 to October 1; and from April 15 to the end of school year)

BLACK OR WHITE SOCKS OR TIGHTS

### **GIRLS 5-8**

GLEN PLAID SKIRT: The length of the skirt is to be no shorter than 1" above the knee.

OR BLACK DRESS SLACKS - May be worn all year long with:

1. Short or Long Sleeve White Blouse (Pointed collar)
2. White Turtleneck with ASCA Logo
3. White or Gray Knit ASCA shirt (short or long sleeve)
4. BLACK Uniform Sweater or Vest with ASCA Logo

BLACK WALKING SHORTS or SKORTS – May be worn with White or Gray Knit ASCA shirt and SCHOOL SHOES (May be worn from September 1 to October 1; and from April 15 to the end of school year)

BLACK OR WHITE SOCKS OR TIGHTS

### **BOYS – K- 8**

BLACK UNIFORM DRESS PANTS - May be worn all year long with:

1. White or Gray Knit ASCA shirt (short or long sleeve)
2. White Oxford shirt
3. White Turtleneck with ACSA Logo
4. BLACK Uniform Sweater or Vest with ACSA Logo

BLACK WALKING SHORTS – May be worn with White Knit ASCA shirt and school shoes (May be worn from September 1 to October 1; and from April 15 to the end of school year)

BLACK OR WHITE SOCKS

Gym Uniform: Black sweat pants, and sweatshirt with the ASCA logo may be worn to school on the day gym class. ALL black or ALL white sneakers are to be worn.

Students may wear the black school gym shorts with the ASCA gym t- shirt only. No other t-shirt may be worn. (May be worn from September 1 to October 1 and from April 15 to the end of school year unless otherwise notified by the school office)

Students are required to adhere to the school dress code. A demerit/detention system will be initiated for this school year for infractions. Demerits will be issued from the first day to the last day of school. Each demerit will be reflected on the student development side of the report card. Three demerits earn a detention. Three detentions earn a suspension. Parent/Principal conference will be scheduled to decide next step.
