Information for the Early Childhood program

Age requirements:

Pre K 4: Students must be 4 years of age by October 1, 2009

Pre K 3: Students must be 3 years of age by October 1, 2009

All students participate in daily prayer and learn about our God who loves them.

Faith Formation is the primary purpose for our existence. We support our parents who are the primary educators and role models of faith formation.

The academic program is spearheaded by State certified faculty members.

The teachers follow the Archdiocesan Curriculum Guidelines which are based on the NJ Core Curriculum Standards. Our program includes:

Circle time; Prayer, time, days of the week, months of the year, seasons and weather.

Pre K Math skills; number recognition, counting, one to one correspondence, shapes and patterns.

Pre K Integrated Language Arts; letter recognition, letter sounds, poetry, songs, storytelling, listening skills, creating and sharing their own stories through drawing.
