Dear Parents/Guardians,

Thank you for your interest in All Saints Catholic Academy.

The mission of All Saints Catholic Academy is to provide faith formation and quality education in a Catholic School setting. Our faith based curriculum is what sets us apart from the public schools. Students, faculty, staff and parents work together to create an atmosphere of mutual respect. We strive to develop an environment where each child senses his/her innate value and where each child develops to his/her fullest potential. The learning process is guided by dedicated, committed, qualified faculty members who view learning as a life long process. Each teacher knows his/her students and attempts to instill in them a true love of God and neighbor and a love of learning.

Opportunities and activities are provided which allow the children to develop both gross and fine motor skills. Utilization of a thematic approach allows for the integration of curriculum content from various disciplines such as Religion, Mathematics, Language Arts, Science, Social Studies, Art, Music and Movement. A range of teaching techniques are employed including hands-on activities, small group instruction, learning centers, role playing, manipulatives and puppets. Christian values are integrated into the curriculum by daily prayers and religion lessons, Bible stories and teacher example. Songs, stories and poems are also part of the daily routine. Enrichment subjects offered weekly are Physical Education, Spanish and Library. Computers are in the classrooms and students receive instruction on a rotating basis.

Communication between the teachers and parents is an important aspect of the program at ASCA. We support our parents who are the primary educators and role models of faith formation. Weekly newsletters let families know what is going on in the classroom. Personal meetings, phone calls and e-mails allow the teachers and parents to connect on a more personal level about the child and their progress.

ASCA offers both a full day and a half day option for Pre-K 3 and Pre-K 4. Before Care and After Care are also offered throughout the school year.

Age requirements:

Pre K 4: Students must be 4 years of age by October 1, 2011

Pre K 3: Students must be 3 years of age by October 1, 2011
