Parents,

I appreciate the concern of all the parents. Today we had police presence in the school and a visit from the Mayor of Bayonne who assured us that all is safe in our school. We will continue to have police presence at arrival and dismissal, parked outside, and have walk-throughs in our building throughout the days ahead. Although this is a time of terrible uncertainty, we are doing everything possible to keep our students safe. From the FBI, the state police, and the Bayonne Police Department, we are covered.

With that said we are asking parents to be more aware of the revised procedures that have been recommended to us to secure the building.

- 7:00 AM morning care begins only through the front door. (13<sup>th</sup> Street)
- 7:45 AM arrival time begins through the first red door in the parking lot
- 7:40 AM arrival for PK- students by the red door and PK-3 through the PK-3 door.
- Parents are no longer allowed to call for homework; students will have time to make up homework and class work when they return
- Parents and visitors are NOT permitted to enter the building without an appointment; this will place you on the approval list at the office.
- Parents can still make arrangements to visit classes and perhaps read to the students, but must clear it with the teacher and the teacher will inform the office.

- We will no longer accept drop offs for students (forgotten homework, lunch, reports, books, and projects). We will not let any child go hungry if they forget their lunch.
- All birthday treats must be sent in when students arrive to school.
- All parents and guardians are asked to stay outside for dismissal. Teachers are on duty and will supervise the students. Each student is special to us; we have over 420 special students we need to keep safe, so please work with us to keep all students safe.
- Students will not be permitted to return to school after they leave to retrieve a forgotten book or item. All can wait until the next day.
- Testing in Grades 2-8 will begin either on Thursday or Friday depending on the weather. We have next week to complete them.
- Teachers will post homework; please look on the website for additional information.
- Parents, when you call your child absent for the day, you may email or text the teacher, but you must also call the office. We need the official notification in the office.
- Parents, when you call the school, please identify yourself and your child's name and grade. All inquiries for information, regardless of the source, must be directed to the Administration.
- We need to all work together.
