

## **DRESS CODE**

### **Hair**

**Students' hair must be clean, neatly groomed, and his/her natural color. A neat hairstyle of reasonable length; bangs above the eyebrows for both girls and boys and above the collar in back for the boys is required. No eccentric styles, shavings, colorings, cuts, tails, etc. are permitted. Hair violations will be corrected the same day.**

### **Jewelry/Cosmetics**

**A wristwatch, a ring, post earrings or hoops no bigger than dimes (one in each ear), and a religious medal/cross may be worn. Long or dangling earrings are in violation of the dress code. Boys are not to wear earrings. Girls are not to wear nail polish or make-up. Girls will be sent to the Nurse's office to remove nail polish or make up.**

Flynn O'Hara provides additional (optional) items which enhance our winter uniform, such as blazers for both girls and boys.

**Unless excused by the principal, students wear the uniforms on all school days. The prescribed uniform will be worn at all times.**

## **Girls' School Uniform – Grades K-4**

The following may be worn all year:

1. *Glen plaid* jumper or black uniform dress slacks
2. short or long sleeve white blouse with Peter Pan collar (with the jumper)
3. white turtleneck with ASCA logo (with the jumper or black slacks)
4. white or gray, short or long sleeve, knit ASCA shirt (with the black slacks)
5. black uniform sweater or vest with ASCA logo
6. black or white knee socks or tights

The following may be worn from the first day of school to October 15<sup>th</sup>, and from April 30<sup>th</sup> to the end of the school year:

1. black uniform skort or black uniform walking shorts
2. white or gray knit ASCA shirt
3. black or white knee socks or ankle socks; no show socks are not permitted

## **Girls' School Uniform – Grades 5-8**

The following may be worn all year:

1. *Glen plaid* skirt (no shorter than 1" above the knee)
2. black uniform dress slacks
3. short or long sleeve white blouse with pointed collar
4. white turtleneck with ASCA logo
5. black uniform sweater or vest with ASCA logo
6. black or white knee socks or tights

The following may be worn from the first day of school to October 15<sup>th</sup>, and from April 30<sup>th</sup> to the end of the school year:

1. black uniform skort or black uniform walking shorts
2. white or gray knit ASCA shirt
3. black or white knee socks or ankle socks; no show socks are not permitted

**Please note: Socks (or tights) must be worn at all times**

### **BOYS – Grades K-3**

The following may be worn all year:

1. black uniform dress slacks
2. white or gray, short or long sleeve knit ASCA shirt
3. white, button down collar, dress shirt
4. white turtleneck with ASCA logo
5. black uniform sweater or vest with ASCA logo
6. black socks; no show socks are not permitted

The following may be worn from the first day of school to October 15<sup>th</sup>, and from April 30<sup>th</sup> to the end of the school year:

1. black uniform walking shorts
2. white or gray knit ASCA shirt
3. black or white socks; no show socks are not permitted

### **BOYS – Grades 4-8**

The following may be worn all year:

1. black uniform dress slacks
2. white, button down collar, dress shirt
3. black tie
4. black belt
5. white turtleneck with ASCA logo
6. black uniform sweater or vest with ASCA logo
7. black socks; no show socks are not permitted

The following may be worn from the first day of school to October 15<sup>th</sup>, and from April 30<sup>th</sup> to the end of the school year:

1. black uniform walking shorts
2. white or gray knit ASCA shirt
3. black belt
4. black or white socks; no show socks are not permitted

**Please note: Socks must be worn at all times.**

## **Gym Uniform – All students in Grades K-8**

The following may be worn all year:

1. black uniform sweatpants with the ASCA logo
2. gray gym T-shirt with the ASCA logo
3. black sweatshirt with the ASCA logo
4. black or white socks; no show socks are not permitted

The following may be worn from the first day of school to October 15<sup>th</sup>, and from April 30<sup>th</sup> to the end of the school year:

1. black school gym shorts with the ASCA logo
2. gray gym T-shirt with the ASCA logo
3. black or white socks; no show socks are not permitted

**Please note: Only the gray uniform gym T-shirt may be worn on P.E. days; no other T-shirt may be worn.**

### **Additional Information**

- ❖ **With the exception of the Fridays on which the students attend Mass**, students are permitted, **on Fridays only**, to wear fleeces, sweatshirts, or sweaters that bear the ASCA logo or team name.
- ❖ The principal has the right to give 8<sup>th</sup> grade privileges when it comes to the uniform dress code.
- ❖ 8<sup>th</sup> graders, after their registration to high school and by the permission of the principal, may wear the sweatshirt of their high school in lieu of a school sweater.
- ❖ 8<sup>th</sup> grade boys have the privilege to wear neckties of their choice rather than be restricted to black.
- ❖ 8<sup>th</sup> grade girls have the privilege to wear light nail polish after they receive their high school acceptance letters.

## School Shoes and Sneakers – All students in Grades K-8

Students are permitted to wear shoes or sneakers with their uniform. Shoes are required to meet the following criteria; shoes must:

1. be all black
2. be low-heeled
3. be rubber-soled
4. have closed backs

If sneakers are chosen, they must:

1. be all black (no stripes, designs, or other colors; soles must also be all black)
2. be tied at all times

Boots are not permitted. Uggs and Toms are not allowed for safety purposes.

For gym class solid white sneakers are preferred; black sneakers are permissible provided they meet the aforementioned stipulations.

## Tag Day Guidelines

Students may wear

- jeans
- sneakers
- short socks
- shorts (no shorter than three inches above the knee)
- skirts (no shorter than three inches above the knee)
- skorts (no shorter than three inches above the knee)
- sweatshirts
- jogging suits
- dresses (no shorter than three inches above the knee)
- slacks
- nail polish
- jewelry

Students may not wear:

- flip-flop sandals
- open-back shoes
- tank tops
- T-shirts with inappropriate writing/graphics
- tennis shoes that convert to roller skates
- biker shorts
- pajama pants
- yoga pants
- leggings worn as pants – leggings must be worn with a dress or skirt
- make-up
- low-cut blouses/tops
- clothing that is extremely tight
- hats
- artificial eyelashes

**Please note: Because it is impossible to encompass every eventuality of dress and appearance, the judgment of the Administration is final in these matters. Students who are not in conformity with the Dress Code may incur disciplinary consequences.**
