- Teachers are preparing lessons, will use Classworks, Google classroom, books online, and posting instruction on their *homeworknow* page. We had a planning meeting last week at our Faculty meeting.
- Parents, please make sure you have all passwords to access the above.
- If in case we are instructed to close, we will use **Alert Solutions** as our means of communication for the school; parents may use the teachers' email addresses to keep in touch. Please also check our Web page for additional communication posted.
- If you have changed your email or phone number in the last few months please call the office so we may make the change.

- If you are traveling outside the country over the Easter break, please notify the nurse. We need to know just in case, but we cannot discuss any travel or health concerns due to confidentiality.

We are not in any danger right now. We are taking measures to keep students and staff safe. You can help.

All field trips are cancelled for this year. After our students in grades assigned to see a play at Union Catholic High School, no more field trips will be scheduled. The 8<sup>th</sup> grade trip for graduation is still under discussion.

Reminders:

- Avoid contact with people who are sick. Keep students who are sick home.
- Avoid touching eyes, nose, and mouth
- Follow all rules for students returning to school. (24 fever free without medication, and the same for vomiting).
- Wash hands often. Soap and water is the best practice (20 seconds both sides) Alcohol-base 60% for hand sanitizer.
